BOOSTING UP THE SEED YIELD OF MUSTARD CROP BY ASSESSMENT OF SUITABLE VARIETIES IN VINDHYAN REGION

ABSTRACT : Adoption of Swarna variety of mustard crop significantly increased the seed yield, gross return, net return and B:C ratio during the year 1999-2000, 2000-01 and 2001-02 as compared to Pro-Agro 4001, Pusa bold and Mhyco bold varieties. The average seed yield of these varieties were 14.01, 41.22 and 13.33 q/ha. The mustard variety Swarna manifested 15.78, Rs 17189/ha, Rs 15055/ha and 7.14, seed yield gross return, net return and B:C ratio, respectively
